Medical Benefits (Benefits for Medical Services and Supplies)	 You can use any medical provider, but using a Cigna provider reduces your out-of-pocket costs. In-Network: No cost for preventive care. Copayments for visit to primary care (\$30), specialist (\$50), emergency room (\$150) and urgent care facility (\$50). For other services: \$900 (single) / \$1,800 (family) deductible, 20% coinsurance and \$4,000 (single)/ \$8,000 (family) out-of-pocket maximum. Out-of-Network: \$2,000 (single) / \$4,000 (family) deductible, then Plan pays 70%; maximum out of pocket: \$8,000 (single) / \$16,000 (family). Prescription Drug Benefits	 In-Network Retail Pharmacy: Copayment for generic (\$12) / 20% coinsurance for preferred brand (\$30 min/\$70 max) / 50% coinsurance for non-preferred brand (\$75 min/\$150 max) for 30-day supply. Cigna's Home Delivery Program: Copayment for generic (\$24) / 20% coinsurance for preferred brand (\$60 min/\$140 max) / 50% coinsurance for non-preferred brand (\$150 min/\$300 max) for 90-day supply. Out-of-Network: Not covered. 	
Dental Benefits	 You can use any dental provider, but using a Cigna provider generally reduces your out-of-pocket costs. Out-of-network services are subject to the reasonable and customary allowance (<i>i.e.</i>, the amount that Cigna determines is typical for the service in the geographic area in which you obtain the service). In- or Out-of-Network: No cost for preventive care. For non-orthodontia services, \$50 (individual) / \$150 (family) deductible, then Plan pays 80% for basic and 60% for major services up to a \$2,000 annual maximum per person. Orthodontia services are covered at 50% up to a \$2,000 lifetime maximum per person. 	
Eye-Care Benefits (Benefits For Vision Exams And Eyewear)	 You can use any eye-care provider, but using an EyeMed provider provides greater benefits. In-Network: No cost for annual exams and lenses. Allowance for eyeglass frames and contacts. Out-of-Network: Costs determined according to a schedule based on the type of service. Life and Accidental Death & Dismemberment (AD&D) Coverage (Financial Protection In The Event Of Death Or Accidental Loss)	 Flat \$1,000,000 payable to your beneficiary if you die from any cause while covered. An additional benefit is payable, according to a schedule, if you die or suffer a loss as the result of a covered accident. 	NBA Players' Health Service Center: 855-497-6669, Option 1, then Option 4
Disability Benefit (Financial Protection In The Event Of Disability)	 Eligibility: Active Two-Way Players only, so long as the disability occurs while covered and before age 35. Benefits: Insured by Houston Casualty Company ("HCC"). Subject to the Collective Bargaining Agreement, the disability benefit is \$400,000 payable to you after a 12-month elimination period during which you remain permanently totally disabled. Tuition Reimbursement Benefit (Reimburses Eligible Education-Related Costs For Qualifying Education Programs)	The Tuition Reimbursement benefit encourages the growth and development of your skills, abilities, and knowledge off the court by providing reimbursement for eligible academic fees, including textbooks and tuition costs for qualifying education programs. The benefit also covers certain expenses for tutoring and test preparation courses. Eligible players can receive up to: \$41,667 per year in tuition reimbursement, with a lifetime maximum benefit of \$125,000 (and an annual usage limitation of \$62,500). A player with three (3) or more years of credited service can choose to use their benefit during or after their playing career. A player with one (1) or two (2) years of credited service must use the benefit while they are playing. 401(k) Savings Plan (A Savings Plan For Retirement)	 You will be automatically enrolled in the pre-tax 401(k) contribution each year equal to the maximum permitted by law, unless you timely elect otherwise. The maximum contribution for 2024 is \$23,000. For 2024, your team matches 140% of your pre-tax savings (in 2024, a match of \$32,200 for players who contribute the maximum of \$23,000). You can also contribute an additional amount on an after-tax basis. All contributions are credited with investment earnings/losses while in the plan. You select investments from a menu of options. Pension Plan (A Plan That Provides A Benefit For Retirement)	 Once you are credited with three years of NBA service, you can receive your normal retirement monthly benefit at age 62 or reduced benefit as early as age 45; a portion of your benefit may be available as a lump sum. In general, effective with the 2023-24 season, you are credited with a year of NBA service for an NBA season during which you are either: on the active list, inactive list, or two-way list of any NBA team as of February 2 of that season (excluding players under a 10-day contract), or on the active list of one or more NBA teams for at least 50% of regular season games during that season. Your pension benefit grows as you earn additional years of NBA service (subject to IRS maximum benefit limits). HRA Benefit (A Health Reimbursement Account you can use to Pay for Healthcare Expenses or Obtain Coverage after your NBA Playing Career Ends)	 When provided for under the Collective Bargaining Agreement, you receive a tax-free contribution to your health reimbursement account (HRA) for each year of NBA service (as described above). The contribution is \$30,000 per season (with a lifetime maximum of \$150,000). You may access your HRA funds only after earning 3 years of NBA service. Tax-free reimbursements of eligible out-of-pocket healthcare costs (e.g., copayments, deductibles, and prescription and over-the-counter drugs) and certain post-career health insurance coverage costs. Retiree Health and Welfare Benefits (Medical, Dental and Vision Benefits For Eligible Retired	 Once you are credited with three years of NBA service, you are eligible for the following benefits: Retiree Medical Benefit: Eligible retired players may elect retiree healthcare coverage through UnitedHealthcare® for themselves and, in some cases, their families at no charge to the player for the cost of premiums for such coverage. You can use any provider for medical care, although using a UnitedHealthcare® network provider generally reduces your out-of-pocket costs. Retiree Dental Benefit: Retiree dental coverage is offered through Cigna. The cost of this coverage is 100% paid by the retired player.
